Objective of the Program:

- The objective of the program was to inspire inclusion of Women in all developmental activities for inclusive development of the World as well as to create awareness against abuse and exploitation of women and achieve progress in women's equality.
- To create awareness against Child Marriage.

Brief of the program:

The program started at 12 noon. There were total 200 participants.

The program was started with a brief introductory meeting. The program was chaired by Dr. Ranen Chandra Muchahary, Principal Basugaon College.

Ms. Surashree Pathak, District Child Protection Officer, Chirang was the Chief Guest of the Program. Ms Mushahary of District Hub for Empowerment of Women, Chirang was the Key Speaker of the Program.

Mrs. Anamika Bhagabati Sarma, Convenor Women Empowerment Cell, Basugaon College explained the objectives of the program.

At the beginning of the program Dr. Ranen Chandra Muchahary, Principal Basugaon College, Ms. Surashree Pathak, District Child Protection Officer, and Ms. Mushhary of District Hub for Empowerment of Women, Chirang were felicitated with Arnai and Gamocha.

Ms. Mushhary of District Hub for Empowerment of Women, Chirang gave her key note address of the program. In her speech she explained the significance of celebration of International Women's Day and theme of the International Women's Day 2024 i.e. "Inspire Inclusion".

She explained that the all round development of the world is possible only through inclusion of Women in all developmental activities. That is all (men & women) needs to be inspired for inclusion of women in all sphere of activities. When we inspire others to understand and value women's inclusion, we take a step for better world. And when women themselves are inspired to be included, there's a sense of belonging, relevance, and empowerment. Worldwide, women must be included in all fields of endeavour.

She stressed that initiation should be started from every individual home. Women in every home should be given equal status. Male members should start doing the jobs, which are traditionally being done by women only, such as cooking, cleaning of utensils, cleaning of house, etc. Similarly woman member of a house should start doing jobs which are being traditionally being done by male member.

Ms. Mushahary. used numbers of posters in her speech to make the address easily understandable to the students.

Mrs. Bhaswati Choudhury, Head of Education Department & Vice Principal Basugaon College in her brief speech stated that implementation of this year's theme of "inspiring inclusion" in latter and spirit will do a lot towards women's equality in the Society. In India off late we are witnessing that many women have started doing activities which are being traditionally being done by male such a driving commercial vehicles, car mechanics, etc and this is very encouraging trend.

She viewed that the Society including Government, various organisations, Groups, etc needs, inter-alia, to take following steps for ensuring inclusion of women in all sphere of activities of the Society:

- Providing women and girls with access to quality education and training
- Recruiting, retaining and developing women in diverse talent
- Supporting women and girls into leadership, decision-making, business, etc
- Designing and building infrastructure meeting the needs of women and girls
- Elevating women and girl's participation and achievement in sport etc

Ms. Surashree Pathak, Child Protection Officer, Chirang and the Chief Guest of the Program in her lucid and valuable speech inter-alia gave detailed account of the various schemes launched by Government of Assam and Government of India for women, which ensure wider participation of women in all sphere of activities. Ms. Pathak also spoke in details about the movement started by Government of Assam for elimination of Child Marriage from Assam.



The representatives of Kosi Lok Manch, Chirang, while supporting the movements started by Government of Assam recently for Child Marriage Free Assam, spoke about the urgent need for elimination of Child Marriage from Indian Society as the Child Marriage is the root cause of many of the ailments of Indian Society such of lack of education amongst girls, poor health of girls, substantial increase in population.

The representatives of Kosi Lok Manch, Chirang, impressed upon the participants to spread the message of the need for elimination of Child Marriage amongst all section of the Society. He also requested the participants to inform the police and other concerned Government Officials if any instances of Child marriage come to their notice.

A quiz competition was also arranged amongst the student participants. The winners of the Quiz Competition were also given Certificates and Prizes.

Dr. Ranen Chandra Muchahary, Principal Basugaon College gave concluding speech as the Chairman of the program. Dr. Muchahary, inter-alia, stated that a large number of girls students are studying at Basugaon College and their performances are also encouraging. He also stated that Women Empowerment Cell of Basugaon College is conducting number of workshop / program for all round development of girls students. At the end Dr. Muchahary expressed his gratitude to Ms. Pathak, Chief Guest and Ms. Muchahary for their participation and valuable speeches.

Outcome and benefit of the program:

Presence and enthusiastic participation of large number of students and staff made the program successful.

The program was successful in creating awareness amongst the participants the need for encouraging participation of women in all sphere activities of the Society. Women inclusive developments can only bring all round equitable development of the Society.

The program was also successful in creating awareness against Child Marriage. Child Marriage is one of the main reasons for early drop out of girl students from schools and colleges as well as poor health of women.

After the conclusion of the program Women & Child Development Department, Chirang distributed lunch packets amongst the participants.




